



3 SCHOLARSHIP OPTIONS

Education, training and career support for eligible adults

Choose the program that best matches your education and employment goals.

LOW-INCOME SCHOLARSHIP | College or vocational education

AWARD

Full-time: \$1,500
Part-time: \$750
Per semester

Best for: Low-income adults pursuing an accredited college, university, vocational or approved credential program.
May help pay for: Tuition, fees, books, required supplies, certification costs, basic required technology, childcare and career-readiness expenses.
Duration: May be renewed for up to 4 semesters, based on continued eligibility and available funding.

2

SINGLE PARENT SCHOLARSHIP | Education support for parents

AWARD

Full-time: \$1,500
Part-time: \$750
Per semester

Best for: Single parents who have custody or documented responsibility for at least one dependent child under age 18.
May help pay for: Tuition, fees, books, required supplies, certification costs, technology, and childcare tied to class, work, clinicals or training.
Duration: May be renewed for up to 6 semesters, based on continued eligibility and available funding.

3

TRANSITION OUT OF POVERTY (TOPs) | Short-term career advancement

AWARD

Up to \$500
Every 12 months

Best for: Adults pursuing a credential, certification, license, apprenticeship, workforce training or short-term career advancement program.
May help pay for: Training and testing fees, books, tools, uniforms, required technology, licensing, and approved transportation or childcare costs.
Duration: Continued assistance requires documented progress toward education, employment and self-sufficiency goals.

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY

Age 18+ | Household income at or below 200% of Federal Poverty Guidelines | Approved education or training pathway
Participation in case management and progress monitoring is required. Applicants may receive only one CADC scholarship at a time.
